Do you want to help survivors of sexual violence rebuild their lives?

Survive is recruiting one additional Support Worker to work with survivors of rape, sexual assault and child sexual abuse.

The post holder will be based in York, with the possibility of working in the office and from home. The role is permanent, subject to the probationary period of 6 months. The post holder will work with adult survivors of sexual violence who self-refer to *Survive* or who are referred by other professionals.

You will have overall responsibility for a caseload of clients in York and offer up to six one-to-one sessions online, over the phone or in person. You will also carry a caseload of clients living across North Yorkshire, however you will only work remotely with these clients. The role also includes covering 1-2 remote shifts per week on our helpline, which operates Monday – Thursday between 10am-12pm.

The post holder must be able to work at least 1-2 hours on Monday afternoons to attend team meetings. Other working days can include Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday, and this can be flexible. Successful candidates will also need to be flexible during the training period. Training and induction are held in York and some training can be carried out whilst working from home.

Successful candidates will need to undergo enhanced DBS checks (costs covered by *Survive*) and will be expected to deliver support sessions face-to-face, online or over the telephone.
